Executive Session
November 17, 2015

Village Clerk, Kim Yearry, took roll call. Trustees in attendance are, Nancy Falk, Rusty Karr, Suzanna Holland, Rosalie Summers, John Goergen and Mandy Huff. President Rick Karr and Village Attorney Steve Marht were also in attendance.

The council discussed the hiring of a new employee on a part-time basis. Rusty Karr explained this person comes highly recommended from a very reliable source. This potential employee has a current CDL and is going to college so part-time would fit right into his schedule. He has his own plow if the village would get in a pinch and need it. Rusty Stamp cannot drive right now for the next six month due to health issues. The village has no work for Rusty Stamp at this time. Rusty Karr stated he is not going to try to hunt for work for Rusty Stamp. All the work at the shed is done for the season and things are ready for winter. Rusty Stamp could still read meters if weather permits but right now he is on an on call basis, he is considered seasonal-part-time. Henry would be our second CDL driver for the village. Rust explained that no overtime is allowed without approval by the department head. It is not up to any employee to decide to work overtime without department head approval before the fact. All employees have been informed the village work hours are from 8 AM to 5 PM with an hour lunch. Rusty Stamp still is coming in early even after being told the working hours. Rich explained that if he comes in early he is not on the clock till 8. John agreed that there needs to be a set start time.
